

Single Section Tapered Shelving with Notched Top Tray






A Pan Head Bolt




B 4-20 x 5/8" Hex Head Flanged Bolt



C #10 x 1" Self-drilling Tek Screw






Step 1


- Bolt one L-bracket to the full-length End Panel flush to the top of the rails
- Bolt the other L-bracket to the Half-Shelf End Panel

Note: See fully assembled diagram of your shelving unit for reference.



• Arrange the full End Panel, Half-Shelf End Panel, and Top Tray <u>face down</u> on the ground and bolt them together (shown here as face up).


Note: So far, only three corners are fastened as shown. The back corner of the full-length End Panel remains unbolted.



- Bolt on the Shelves (see spec. sheet for recommended shelf spacing).
- The topmost shelf must be fastened directly to the Half-Shelf End Panel and requires two holes to be drilled for the bolts.


Note:

- Best done with shelving unit <u>face down</u> on a level surface (shown face up here)
- Slotted holes on each shelf go to the back rail
- Measure and mark on the rails the desired shelf heights
- The topmost shelf is shallower. Lower shelves are full depth.
- Shelves may be mounted upside down or tilted up/down to fit your needs.
- The topmost shelf must be mounted right-side-up.




• Bolt on the other (shorter) End Panel

Note: Make sure the bottoms of the End Panels match up.



• Stand up the shelving unit and bolt on the Angle Support.



- Check all bolts are tight
- Lift the shelving unit into the van and use the provided installation hardware to fasten it to the wall and floor. Follow the install guide.
- Screw the bottom lip to the floor (optional).
